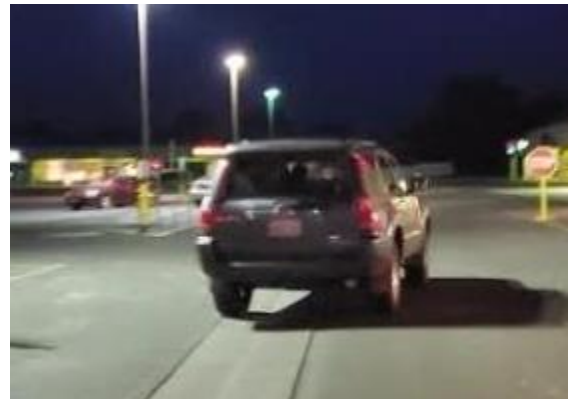

Crime Stoppers of Mesa County are requesting information that will lead to the identification of suspect involved in theft from the Clifton City Market.

On Tuesday, September 14, 2021, at 6:10 am, Officers with the Mesa County Sheriff's Department were notified of a theft containing a large amount of money from the Clifton City Market, located in the 500 block of 32 road. Employees were filling the self-checkout registers when a male subject took the bag containing cash.

Surveillance video captures a White male, with a goatee, wearing a white t-shirt and a black hat. The suspect fled in a SUV, believed to be a Toyota 4-Runner, gray or silver in color, driven by an unknown female.
