Crime Stoppers of Mesa County and the Fruita Police Department are requesting information that will lead to the identification of suspect involved in arson. The estimated property loss is more than \$10,000.

On Sunday, August 29th, 2021, at 1:500 am, Officers with the Fruita Police Department were notified of a fire located at the loading dock of 135 S. Plum Street, The Fruita City Market. Investigation into the origin of the fire indicates the fire was set intentionally.

Surveillance video captures a White or Hispanic male, black or dark brown hair, distinctive eyebrows, and black goatee. Male was wearing a brown sweatshirt with the "Under Armour" emblem in orange on front, and gray sweatpants that were cut off at the bottom with brown lace up boots.
